data




Strategic goals





Core business

- 1. Provide student finance, contributions in study costs Collect tuition fees and study debts
- 2. Pay loans and allowances to candidates for naturalization
- 3. Fund educational institutions
- Organise state exams and naturalization exams, Perform logistical tasks for the central exams in secondary education
- 5. Supervise exam logistics for the Financial Supervision Act
- Collect and process educational data in various databases
- 7. Enrich educational data and make information products
- 8. Authenticate and recognise diplomas; manage the Diploma Register; act as Chairman of the Dutch National Europass Center

attention for basis skills training search for learning motivators






- well succeeded for accredited education
