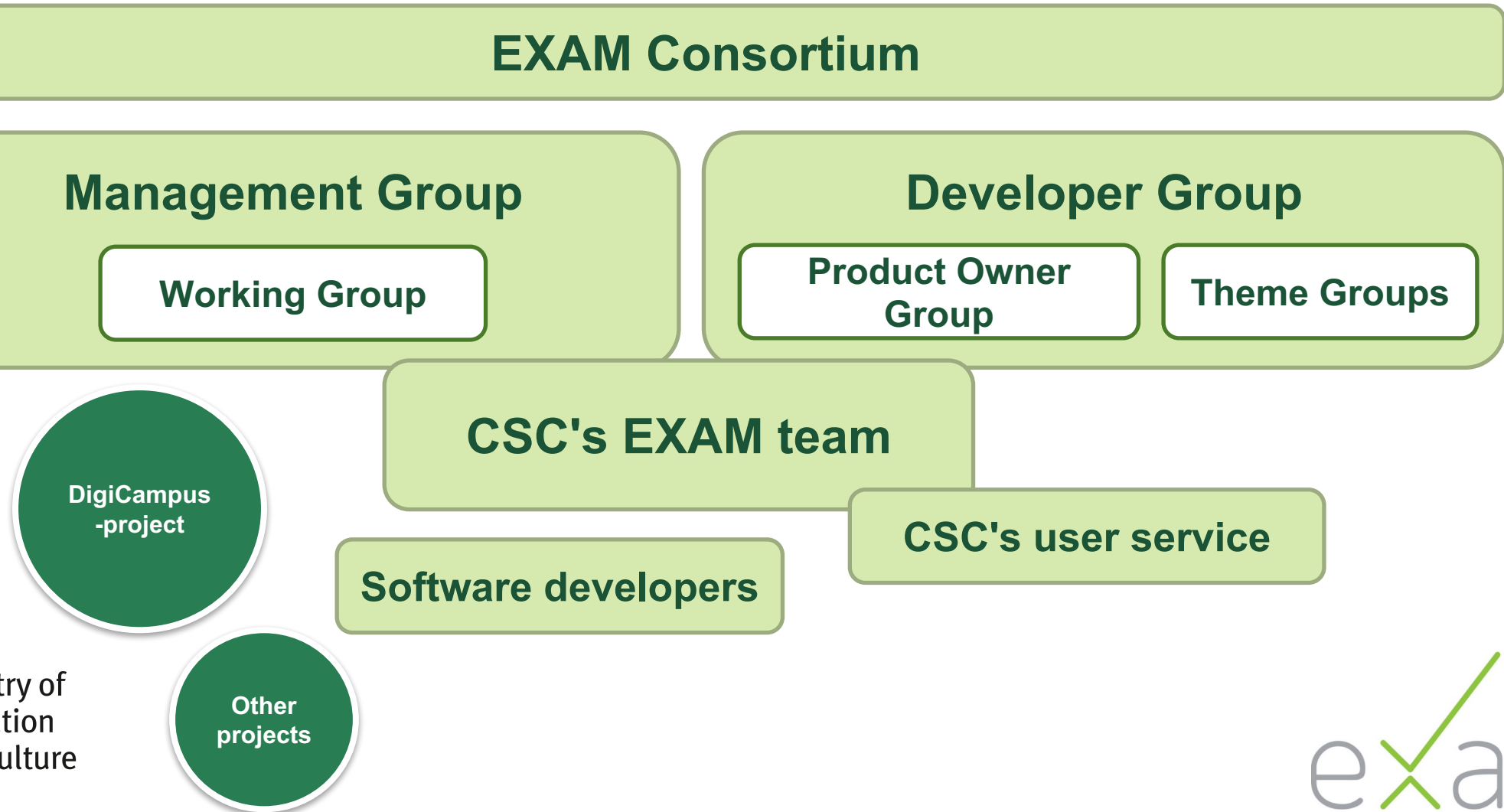
EXAM concept for online exams

EXAM Visit: Joint use of exam rooms

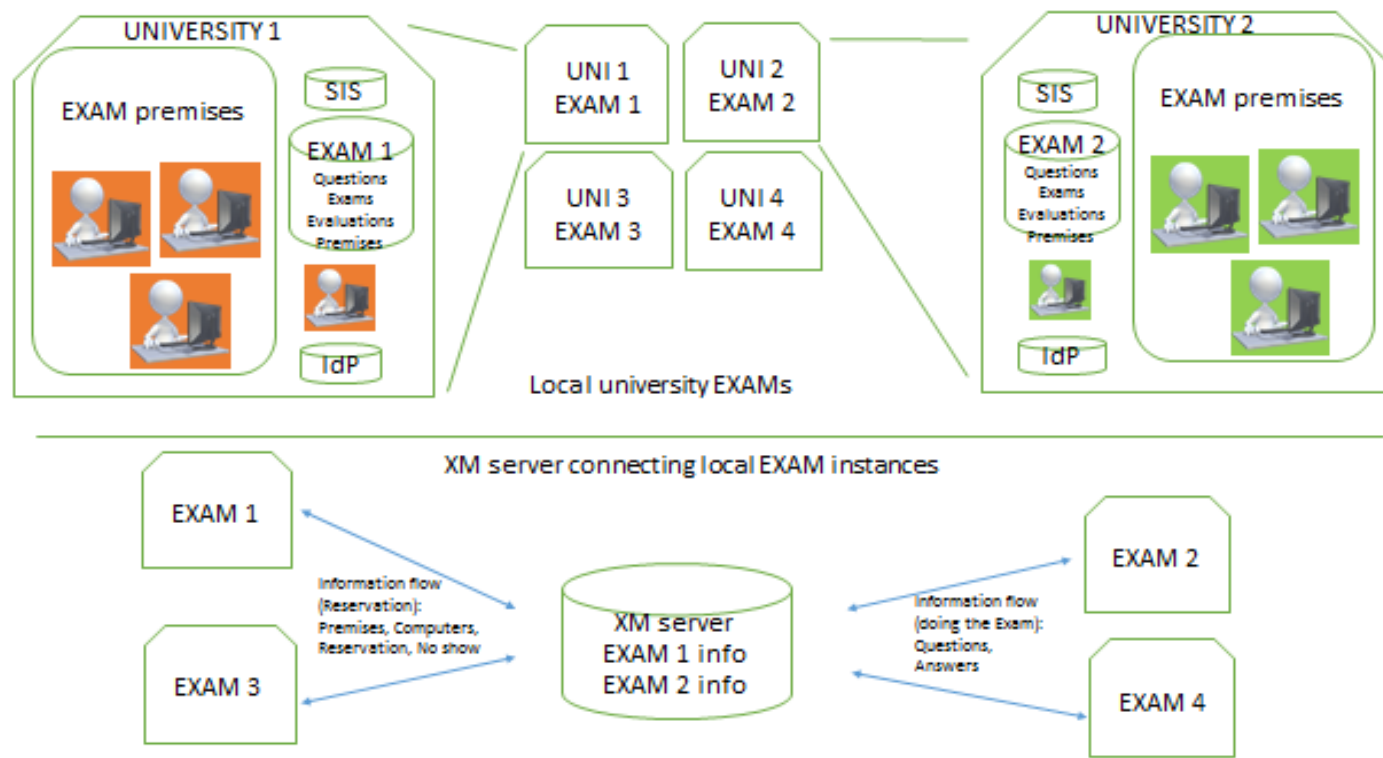
- a model where a student can take an exam of the “home institution” using an other HEI’s exam facilities

Joint exam and evaluation process between two or more universities

- two or more teachers from different universities could create and evaluate a joint exam and students from different universities do it

Shared Resources: technical implementation

The implementation relies on a proxy server which means that the information flows go only through the XM server from a local EXAM instance to another one. This way there is no need to build and open access between the local EXAMs.
