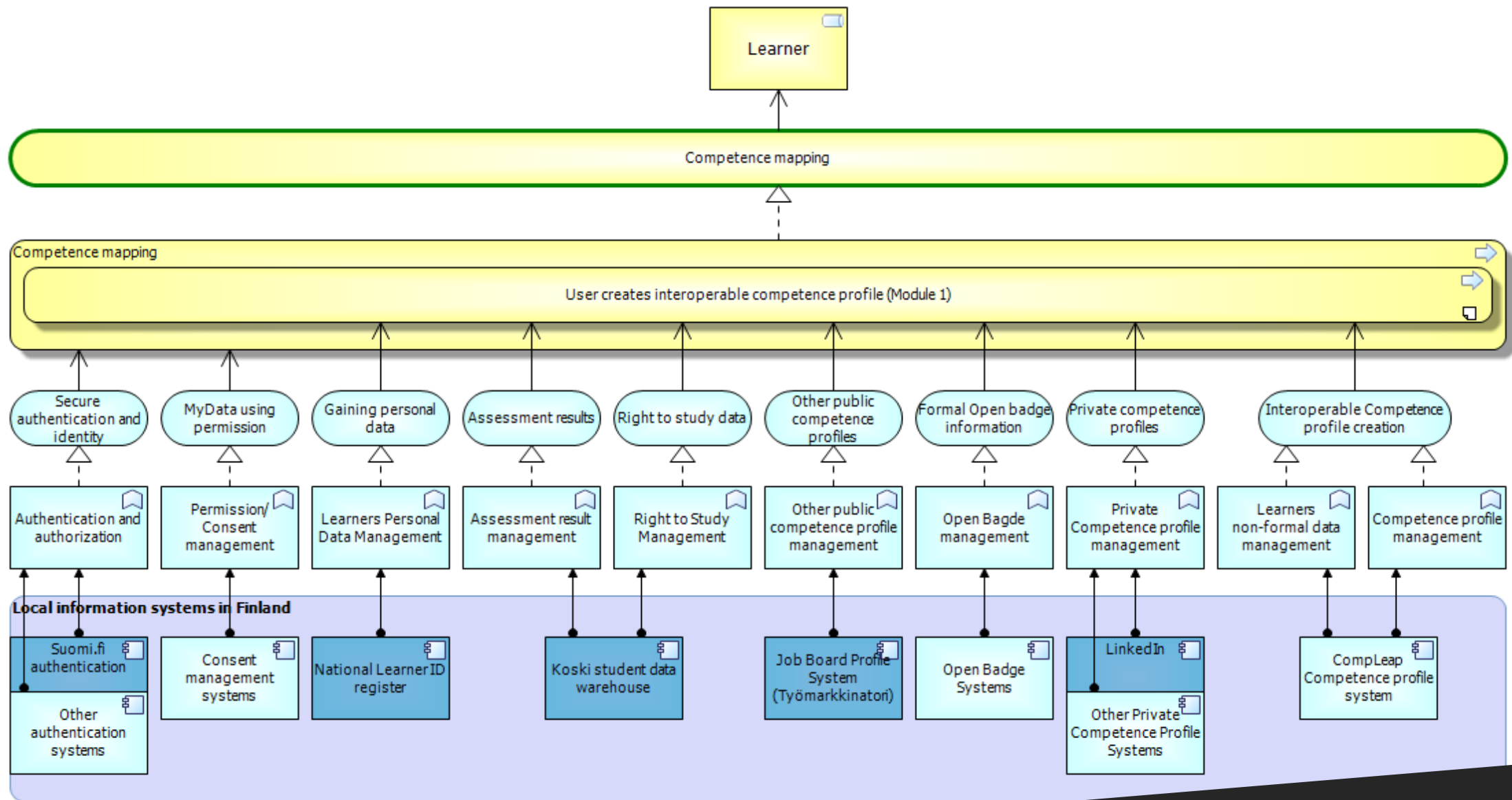
## COMPLEAP

The CompLeap prototypes are developed in four phases:

1. **Mapping architecture** – initial mapping of current service framework
2. **Mock up prototype** – visual screenshots of the modules for testing a concept (ongoing)
3. **HTML prototype** – depicting full framework, linked to architecture deployment
4. **Beta prototype** – development ongoing now, to be piloted with end-users from May

# ARCHITECTURE / HTML

- Architecture works as a foundation for the Learner Path
- Helps understand the ecosystem that we are creating
- Depicting data flows and external data sources as the backbone of the ecosystem
- Crucial for subsequent deployment
